

## BATTERIES



- What:** All batteries, including the rechargeable ones (accumulators).
- Where:** > In the stores where they are sold.  
> In the recycling points.
- When:** During the opening hours of the recycling point: from Monday to Saturday from 7.30am to 10pm and Sunday and Bank Holidays from 10am to 6pm.
- Excluded:** Car batteries.

## BULKY ITEMS



- What:** All bulky items from homes. Maximum of 7 objects of medium size.
- How:** By appointment with "Voirie – Ville propre" by calling 0800 22 42 22, (call and service free) or in a district recycling center (ESREC).
- Where:** At 6.30am the morning of the appointment according to the "Voirie – Ville propre" indications.
- When:** From Monday to Friday from 7am to 11.30am and from 1pm to 4pm.
- Excluded:** Complete storage of apartments, cellars or attics, electrical, electronic and household appliances, light bulbs, special waste (paint, solvents, tires, car batteries, etc.) This service is not available to stores and companies.

## DISTRICT RECYCLING CENTERS (ESREC)



- What:** All waste from houses (special waste, bulky and recyclable, and compostable waste, etc.).  
> Household hazardous waste:  
Chemical and toxic products, paint and solvent, sprays, car batteries, neon lights and long-term electric light bulbs (energy saving light bulbs) and LED, vegetable oils and minerals.  
> Other waste:  
Glass, porcelain, earthenware, ceramics, tires, cartridges and toners, wood scrap, electronic electric and household appliances.
- Excluded:** Waste from stores and companies.
- Where:** **ESREC de la Praille** - Avenue de la Praille 47, 1227 Carouge  
From Monday to Friday: from 2.30pm to 7.30pm,  
Saturday and Sunday: from 9.30am to 5pm.  
**ESREC de Châtillon** - Route d'Aire-la-Ville, 1233 Bernex  
From Monday to Friday: from 2.30pm to 7.30pm,  
Saturday and Sunday: from 9.30am to 5pm.  
**ESREC de Chênats** - Chemin des Chênats, 1293 Bellevue  
From Monday to Friday: from 2.30pm to 7.30pm, Saturday: from 9.30am to 5pm.

## GARBAGE / HOME WASTE



- What:** All household waste that cannot be sorted.  
Stores and companies are allowed 1 bag of 110 liters per pick-up day.
- How:** In plastic bags of 110 liters maximum OKS standard.
- Where:**  
> In plastic rolling containers (800 liters of maximum volume).  
> In a recycling point.
- When:**  
> Between 5am and 6.30am, the pick up day.  
> During the recycling point opening hours: from Monday to Saturday from 7.30am to 10pm and Sunday and Bank Holiday from 10am to 6pm.
- Excluded:** Waste from stores and companies not respecting the norm.

## ORGANIC KITCHEN WASTE



- What:** Food scraps, flowers, damaged products, peels, etc.
- How:** In special biodegradable bags. Green plastic bags are not allowed any more.
- Where:**  
> In plastic rolling containers (140 liters of maximum volume).  
> In a recycling point.
- When:**  
> Between 5am and 6.30am, the pick up day.  
> During the recycling point opening hours: from Monday to Saturday from 7.30am to 10pm and Sunday and Bank Holiday from 10am to 6pm.
- Excluded:** Rinse water from restaurants, cat litter, diapers, sweepings, ash trays waste, chimney ashes, etc.

## ORGANIC GARDEN WASTE



- What:** Branches, grass, leaves, etc.
- How:** In specific biodegradable bags. Green plastic bags are not allowed any more.
- Where:** In plastic rolling containers (800 liters of maximum volume).
- When:** Between 5am and 6.30am, the pick up day.
- Excluded:** Waste from florists, gardening companies and landscape architecture, etc.

## GLASS



- What:** Glass bottles, bowls, jars, etc.
- Where:** In a recycling point.
- When:** During the recycling point opening hours: from Monday to Saturday from 7.30am to 10pm and Sunday and Bank Holiday from 10am to 6pm.
- Excluded:** Glass cups, glass, mirrors, porcelain, pottery, ceramic, etc.

## PAPER - CARDBOARD



- What:** Old papers, folded cardboard, envelopes, magazines, newspapers, etc.  
Tied paper and cardboard are not allowed any more.
- How and where:** > In plastic rolling containers (800 liters of maximum volume), provided by your landlord or the public company of your area.  
> In a recycling point.
- When:**  
> Between 5am and 6.30am, the pick up day.  
> During the recycling point opening hours: from Monday to Saturday from 7.30am to 10pm and Sunday and Bank Holiday from 10am to 6pm.
- Excluded:** Dirty wrapping cartons, dirty table cloths, milk or juice cartons.

## PET



- What:** Beverage bottles with PET logo.
- Where:**  
> In the stores where they are sold.  
> In a recycling point.
- When:** During the recycling point opening hours: from Monday to Saturday from 7.30am to 10pm and Sunday and Bank Holiday from 10am to 6pm.
- Excluded:** Vinegar, milk, shampoo and detergent bottles.

## ALUMINUM AND TINPLATE



- What:** Beverage cans, aluminum foil, mayonnaise tubes, trays, etc.
- Where:** In a recycling point.
- When:** During the recycling point opening hours: from Monday to Saturday from 7.30am to 10pm and Sunday and Bank Holiday from 10am to 6pm.
- Excluded:** Composite packaging with a plastic layer such as a bag of crisps.

## ELECTRIC AND HOUSEHOLD APPLIANCES



- What:** All electronic devices for entertainment.  
(TV, radio cassettes player, hi-fi systems, mobile phones, etc.),  
electric devices (vacuum cleaners, hair dryers, etc.) and household devices  
(washing machine, cooker, fridge, freezer, etc.).
- How:** Free pick up (legal obligation).
- Where:** In stores and manufacturers where they are sold.
- Good to know:** All electronic, electric and household devices can be taken to a district recycling center (ESREC).
